### Coming up.....

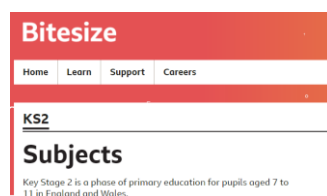

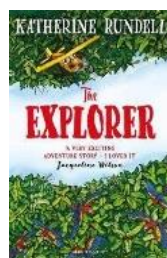
